- Please return your reviews to Michele Folsom, CCSC-NW Papers Chair by Saturday, April 14, 2007.
- Reviews should be emailed to <u>CCSCNW@plu.edu</u> with *CCSC-NW 07 Review* in the subject line.
- Ideally, the reviews should be *received by* the Papers Chair by that date (the Program Committee is meeting soon afterward to set the program). If you are concerned about meeting the deadline, please send an e-mail to the Papers Chair at to <u>CCSCNW@plu.edu</u> letting her know.
- Each review form has **three** parts.
 - The <u>Reviewer Information / Paper Review</u> (with the numerical rankings) and the <u>Comments/Suggestions For Authors</u> part will be seen by **both** the author and the CCSC-NW Program Committee.
 - Comments that you wish to be seen **only** by the Program Committee should be placed on the page labeled <u>Confidential Comments for the CCSC-NW Program Committee</u>.
- Be sure to fill in the paper number at the top of each form with the paper being reviewed.
- Please keep in mind that the Call for Papers encouraged "participation by faculty, staff, and students in Computer Science, Computer Engineering, Computer Information Systems, and other disciplines". Therefore, papers in **any** of these areas are appropriate.
