Notes from national: CCSC next year will migrate to an online journal, *The Journal of Computing Science in Colleges* will be an electronic publication in the Latex format and must be submitted in this format. Online there are examples and steps for the authors to follow.

Paper Selection for April Conference

Eight of the fourteen submitted papers were selected for inclusion in the conference – an **acceptance rate of 57%**.

Tutorial/Workshop/Panel Selection

One tutorials and one panel were submitted, both were accepted, and will run concurrent with the paper sessions.

Program

The selection of tutorial, panel and paper groupings time slots was discussed. Two concurrent paper sessions with one concurrent tutorial/panel session. Each paper will have 25 minute presentation with 5 minute Q&A. The tutorial is an hour, the panel is an hour.

Student posters need to be up by 2 pm, to allow the judges to look at the posters during the day. The session will be an hour.

Conference Discussion

The paper “Analyzing the Impact of Experiential Pedagogy in Teaching Socio-Cybersecurity: Cybersecurity Across the Curriculum” will be awarded the Best Paper for the conference.

The judging of the student posters will be split into two groups, four judges in each group, the student posters will be split in two groups, thus each judge group has one half of the posters to judge. Ties will be decided by the Posters Chair.

A brochure will be included of all the Student Posters submissions to be handed out at registration check in.

Posters chair should bring printed certificates to conference for all students submitting a poster and be prepared to give a certificate to each student at the banquet.

Moderators would be called upon closer to the conference time.

Room for the conference will be assigned later.

The Steering Committee will meet after the dinner reception.
