- Meeting was called to order by Carol Spradling
- Rick moved minutes from March meeting be approved as submitted, David seconded, motion passed.
- Ron handed out copies of the CFP postcard which was distributed at SIGCSE
- Scott S mentioned that the Call For Papers needs to include "In cooperation with SIGCSE." It should be included on anything we publish. Sample is on the SIGCSE website. We also need to include UPE on programs.
- Board report by Carol and Scott S:
  - Use of conftool is ongoing development. Officers that are going to use it this year will meet after today's meeting.
  - Carol will submit 2014 budget to board prior to March board meeting. Ed should get preliminary budget email and can adjust for local costs. They will work with Judy to get submitted.
  - On any major publications we need to list SIGCSE and UPE
  - Need a new tab on website for "next year's conference" so there are links up ahead of time. Michael will take care of this
  - Need links on website for national vendors
  - ACM has a "distinguished speakers program" and will pick up part of funding for speakers from this list.
  - Need to include money in budget for speakers
  - If we are going to ask Henry Walker to set up review process for papers, the paper chair needs to contact him ASAP and see if we can get the server set up. Scott Bell/Bob Neufeld will contact Henry.
  - Need to start working on documentation of regional positions/ duties/ responsibilities including a timeline of tasks. There is some preliminary material on national website for that, but not much has been consolidated for our local regional activities.
  - There is documentation for papers chair, treasurer and registrar though may need updating.

Ron will add content to CFP and David Pope will work with him.
